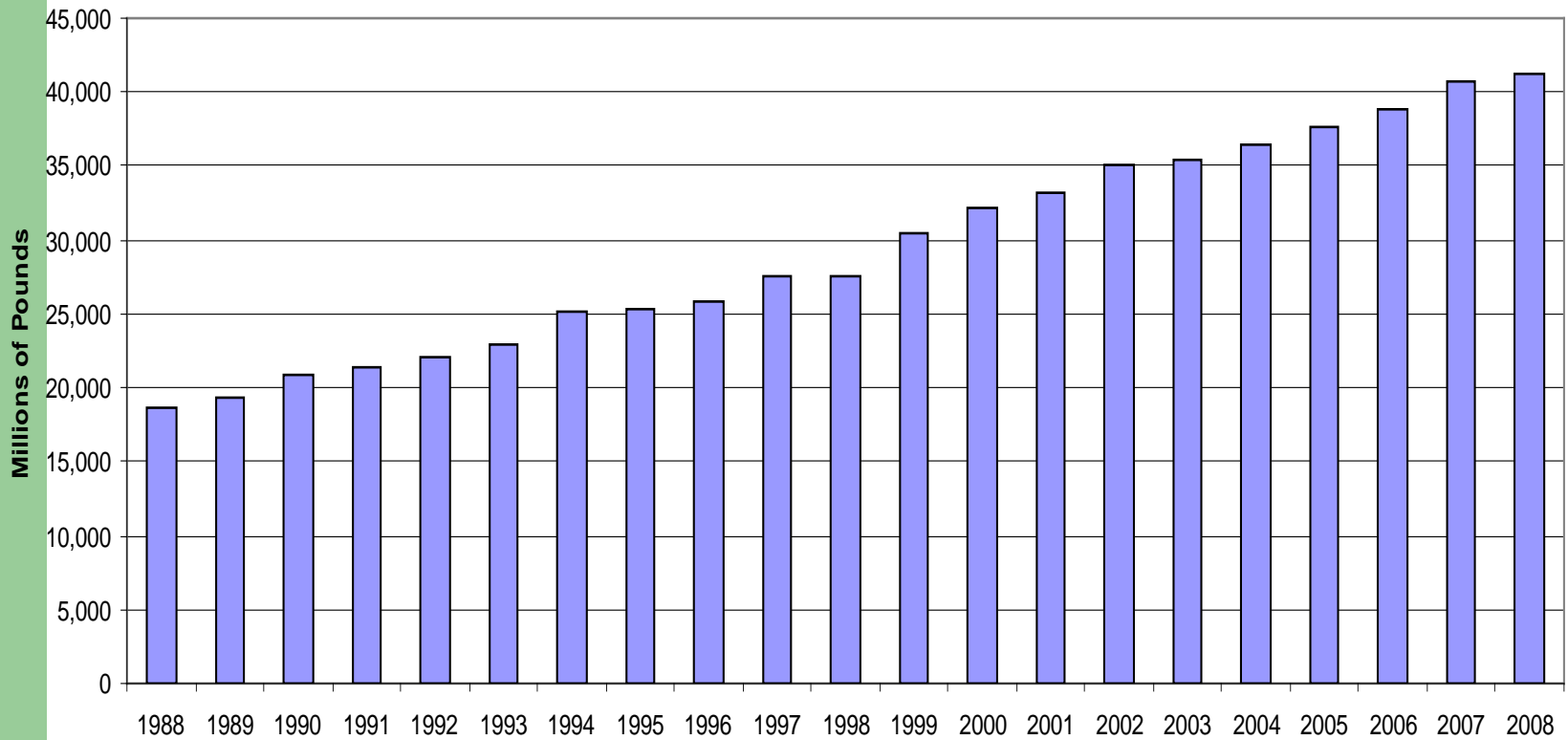

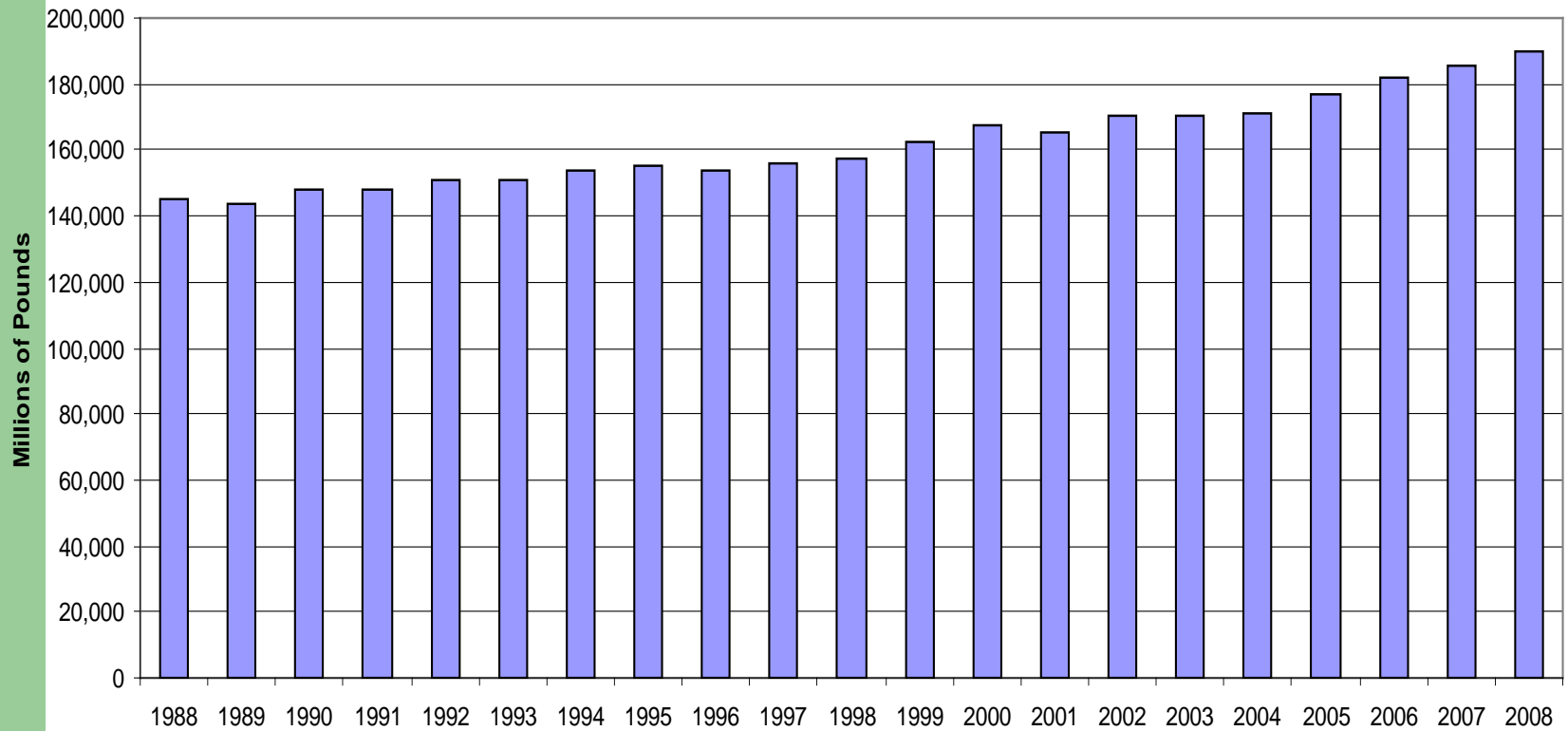


Milk Production in California 1988-2008



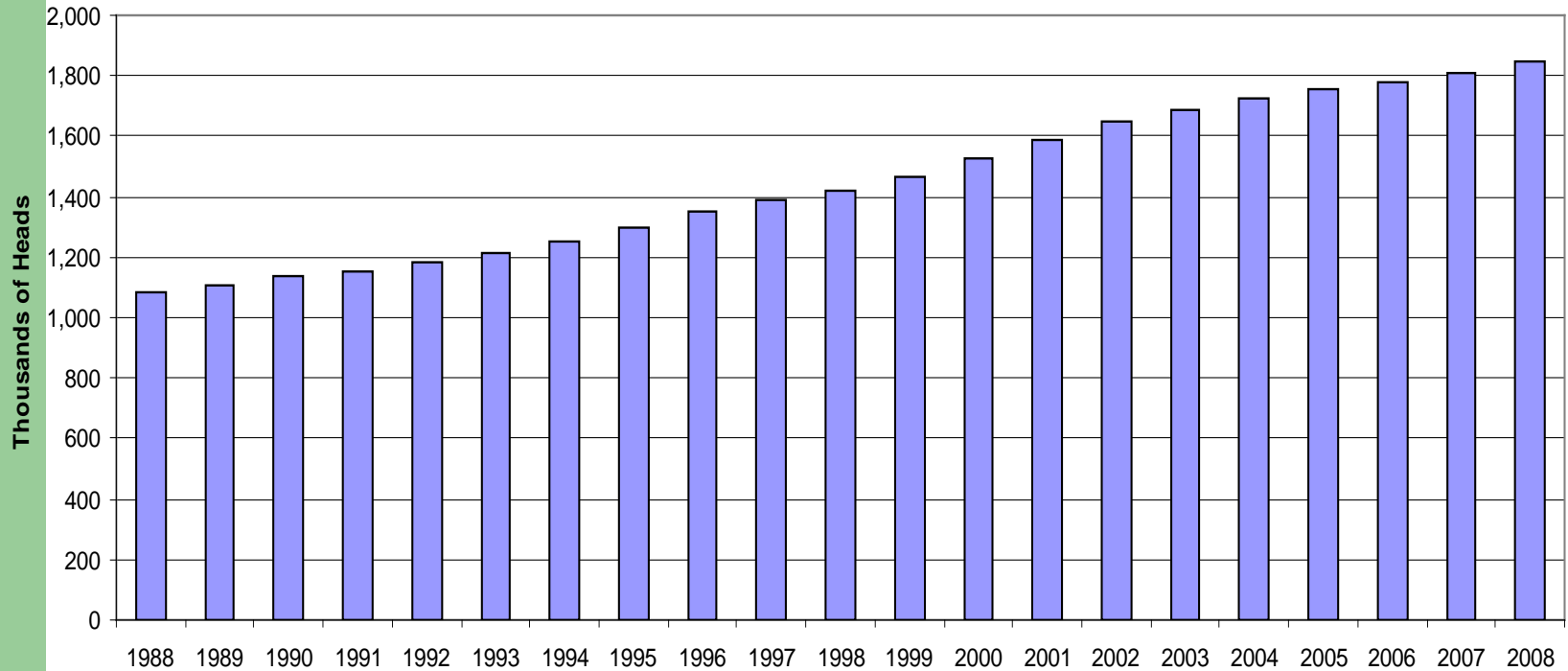

US Milk Production 1988-2008



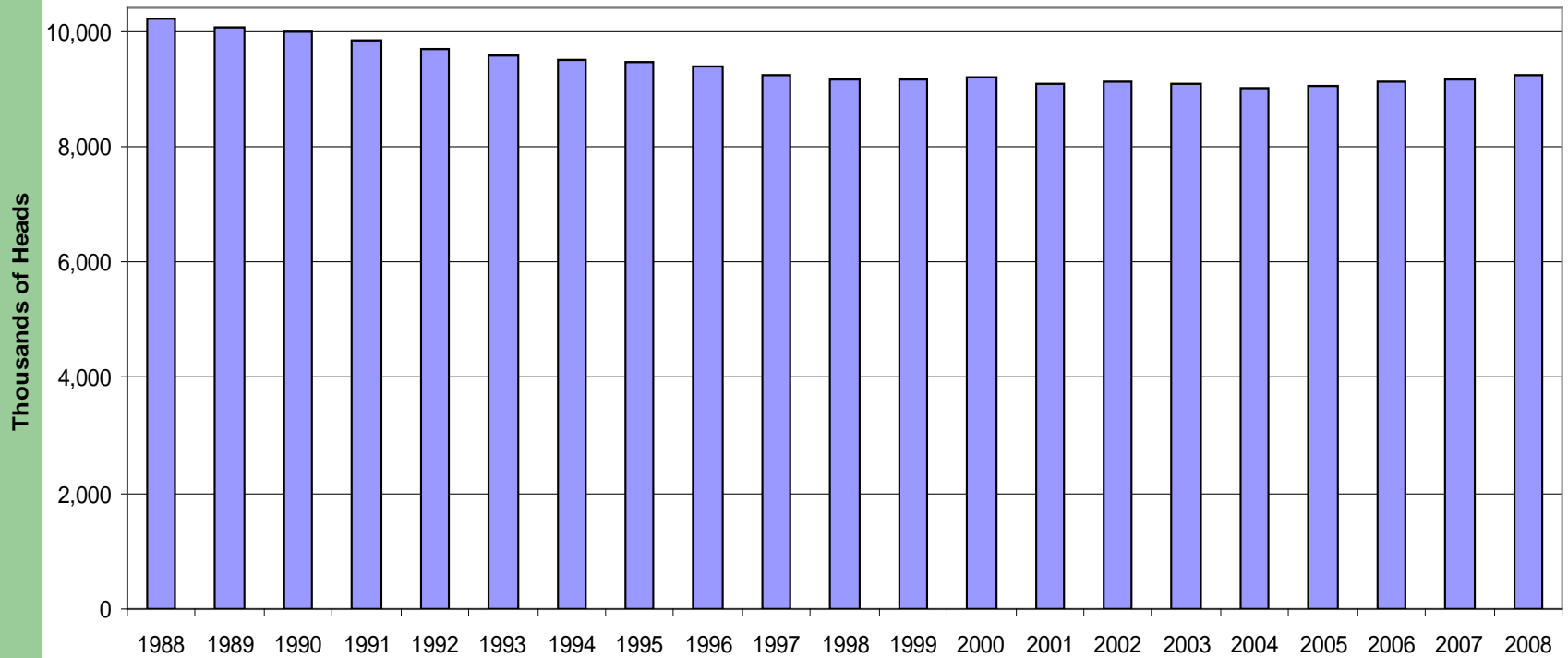

Milk Cows on Farm in California 1988-2008



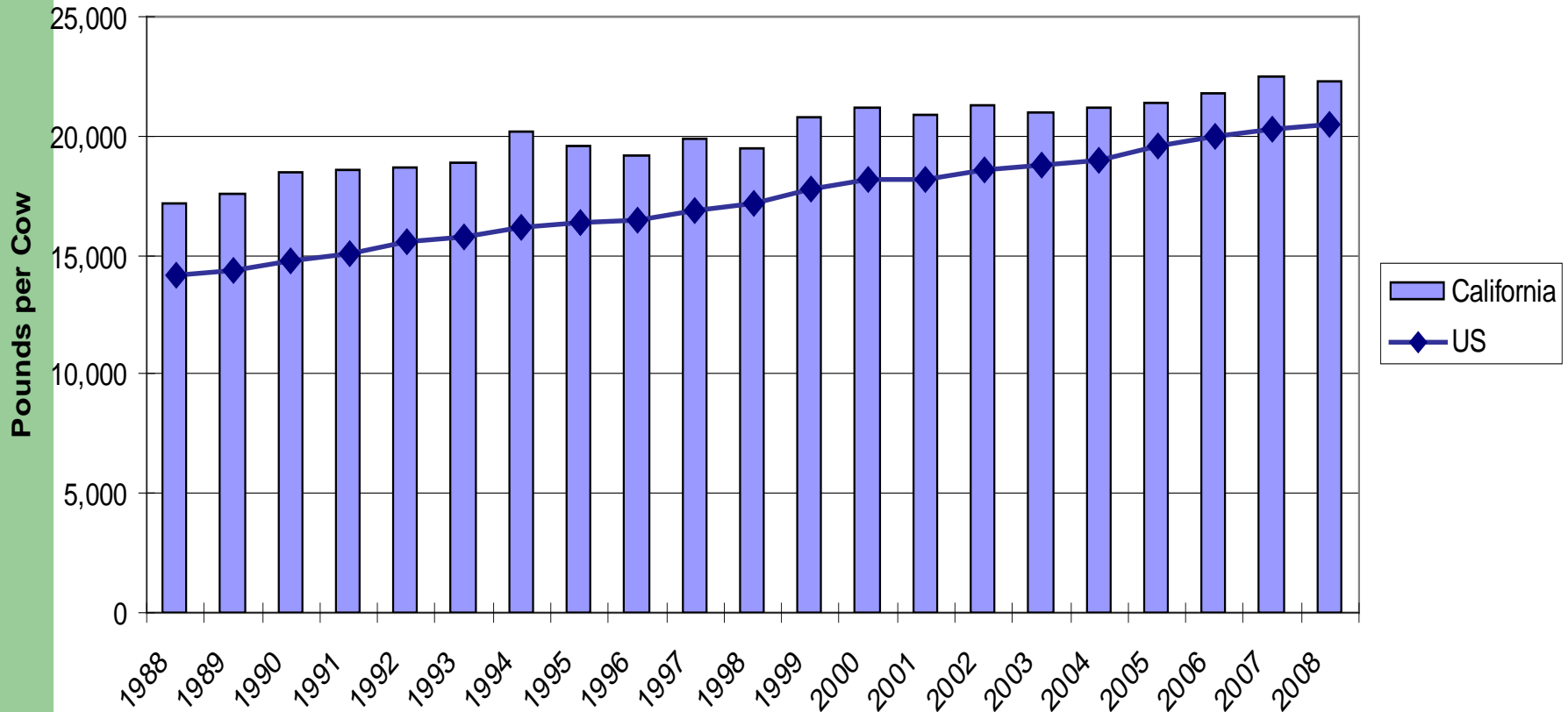

US Milk Cows on Farm 1988-2008



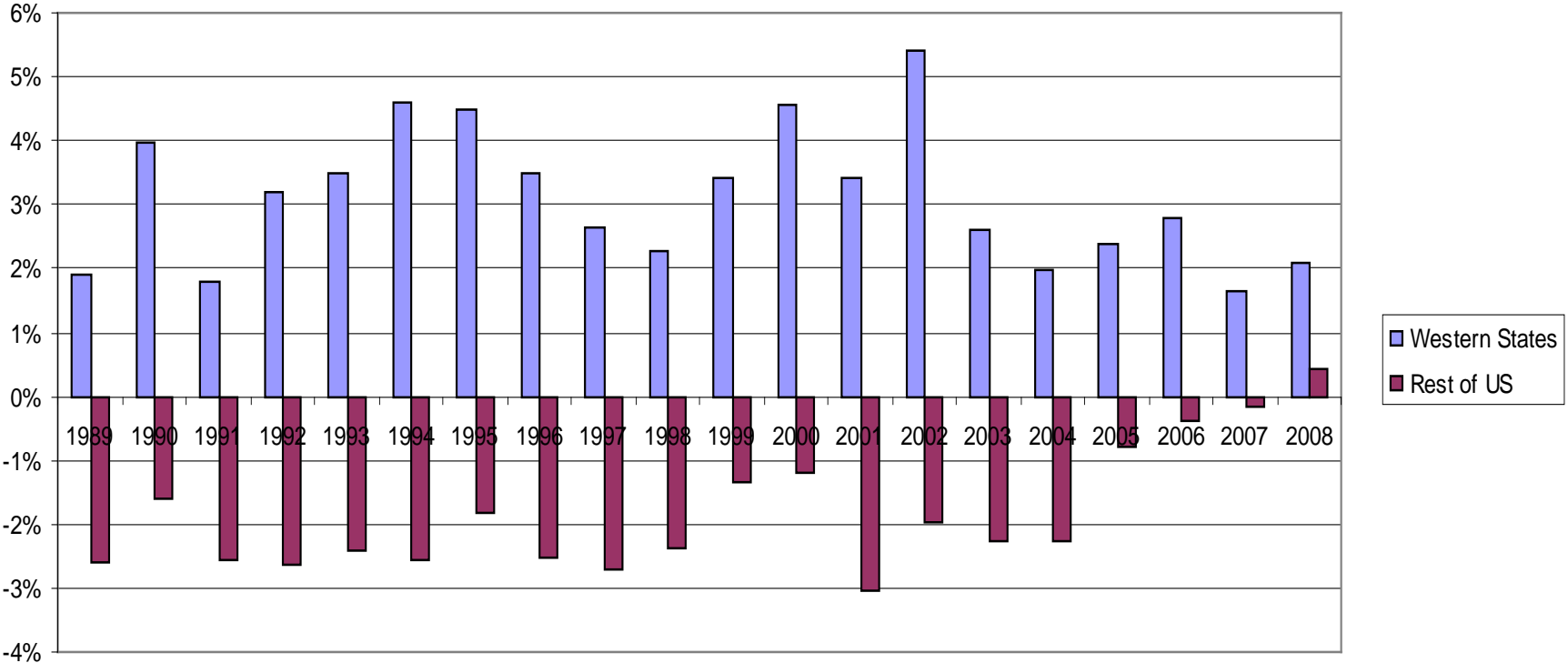

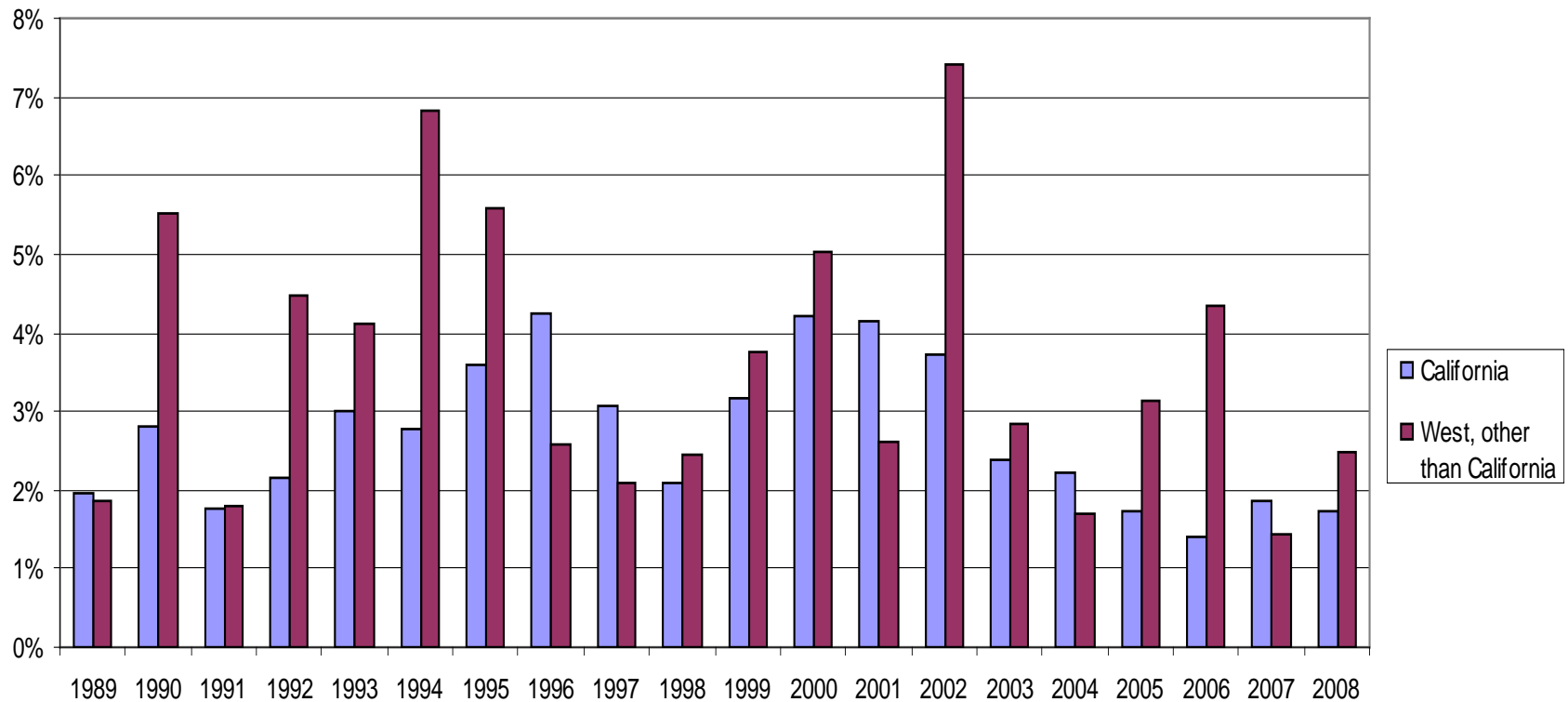
Milk Cows on Farm, Yearly Percentage Change 1988-2008

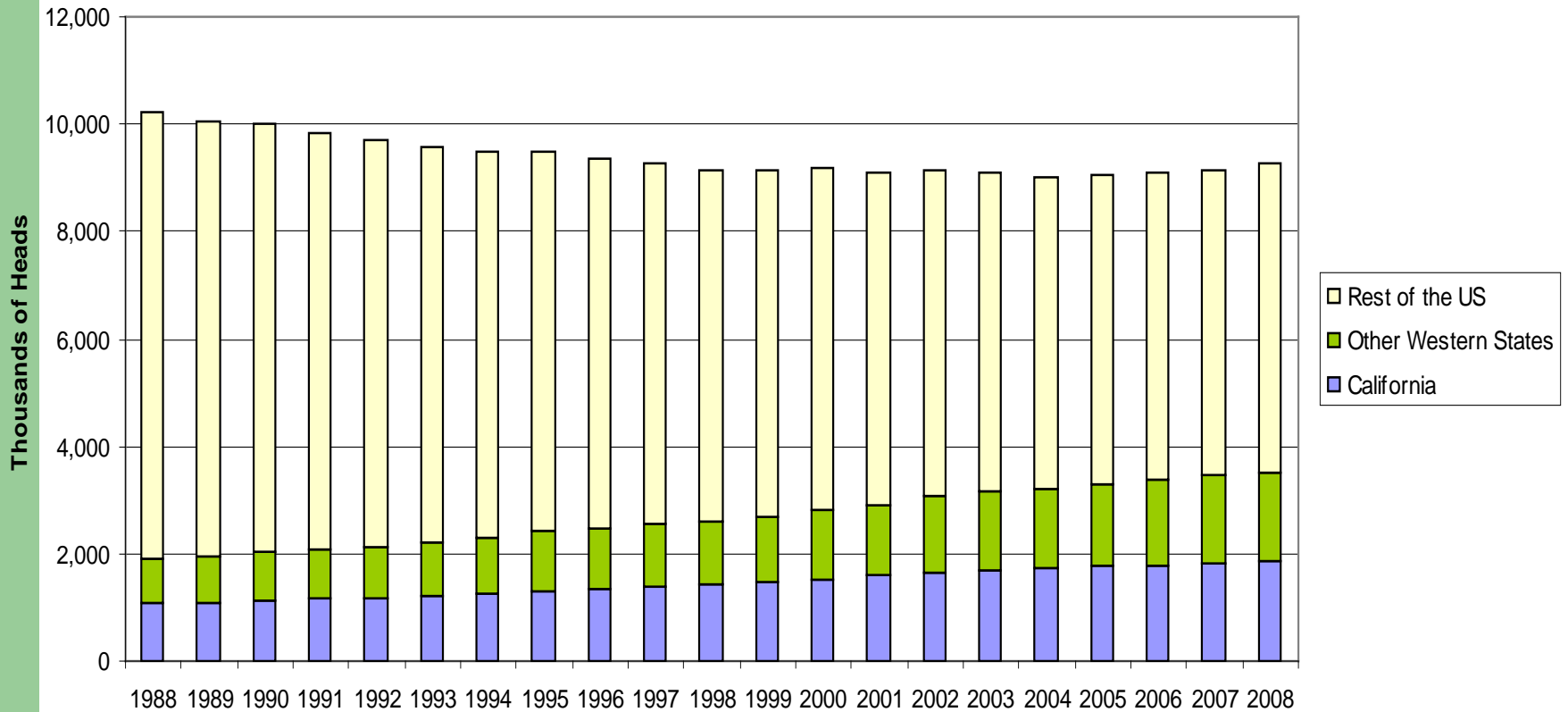

Milk Cows on Farm, Yearly Percentage Change 1988-2008



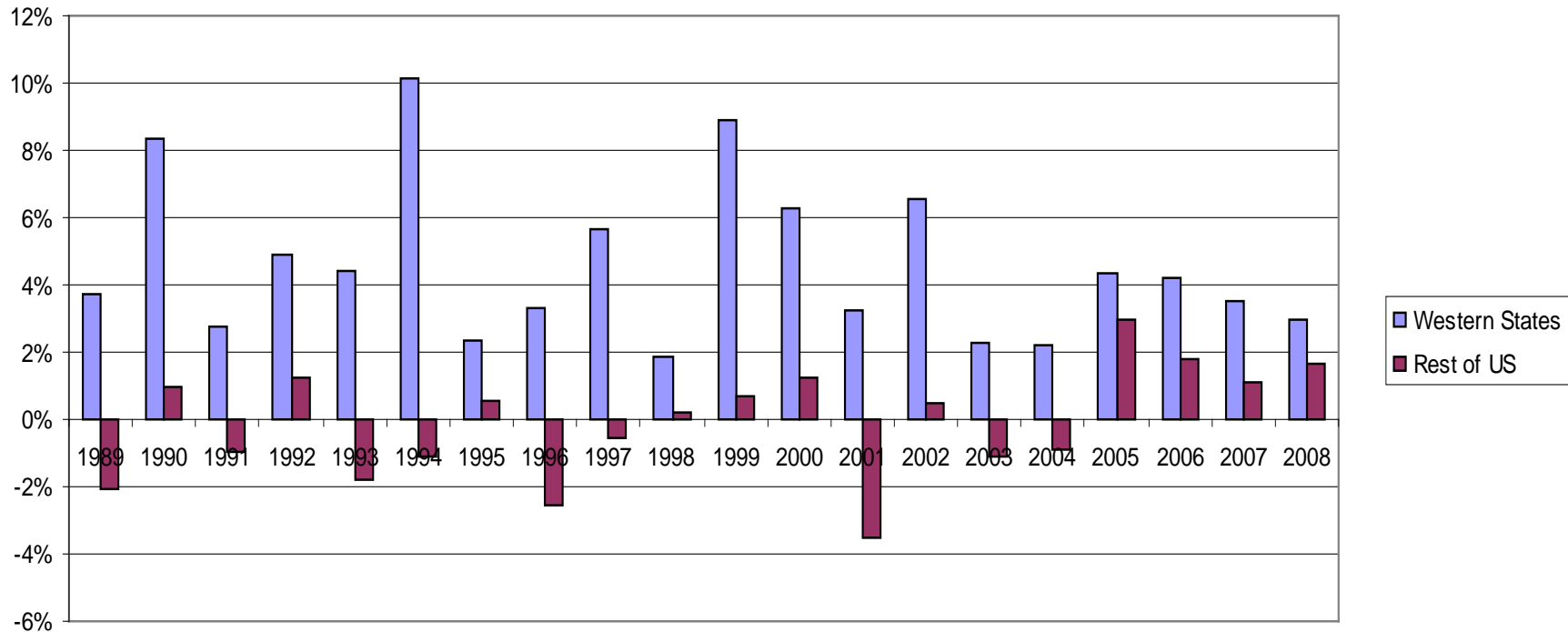

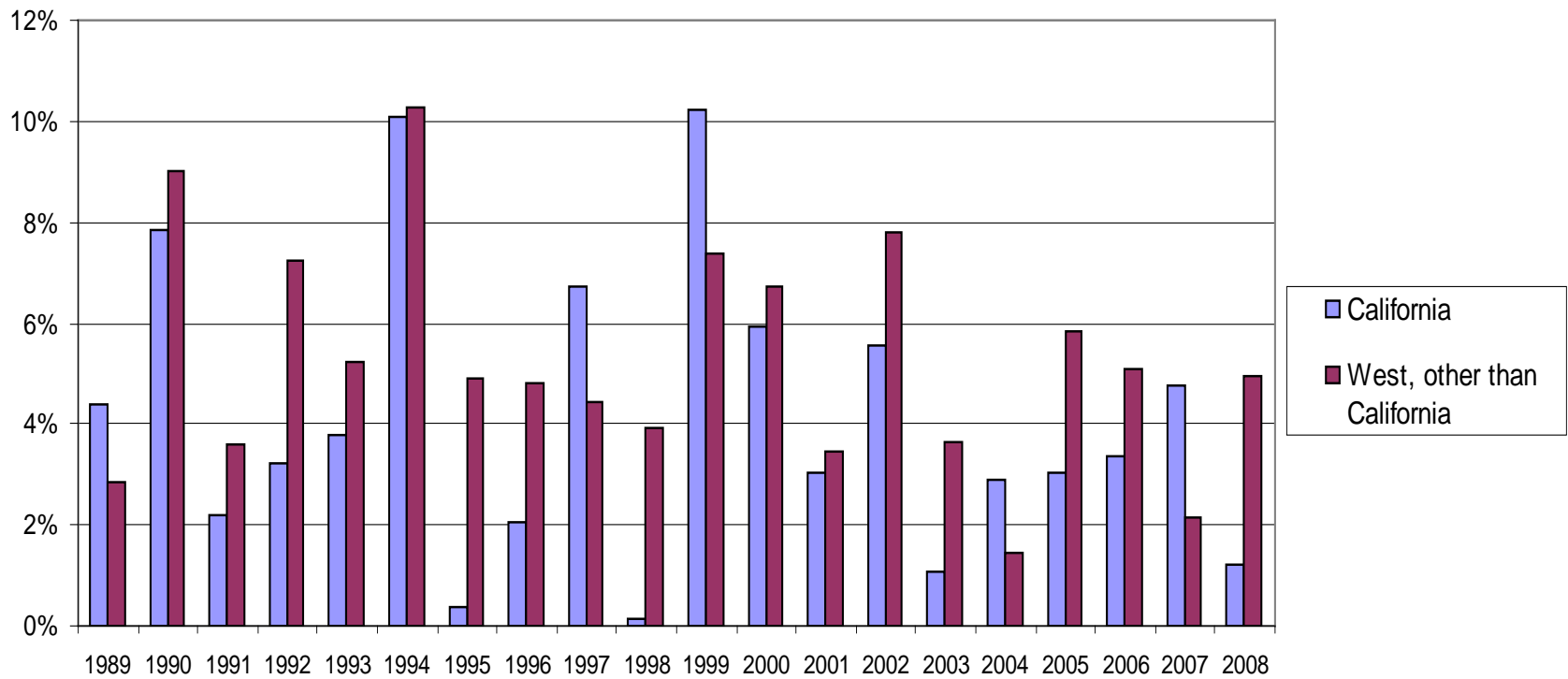
Milk Production, Yearly Percentage Change 1988-2008

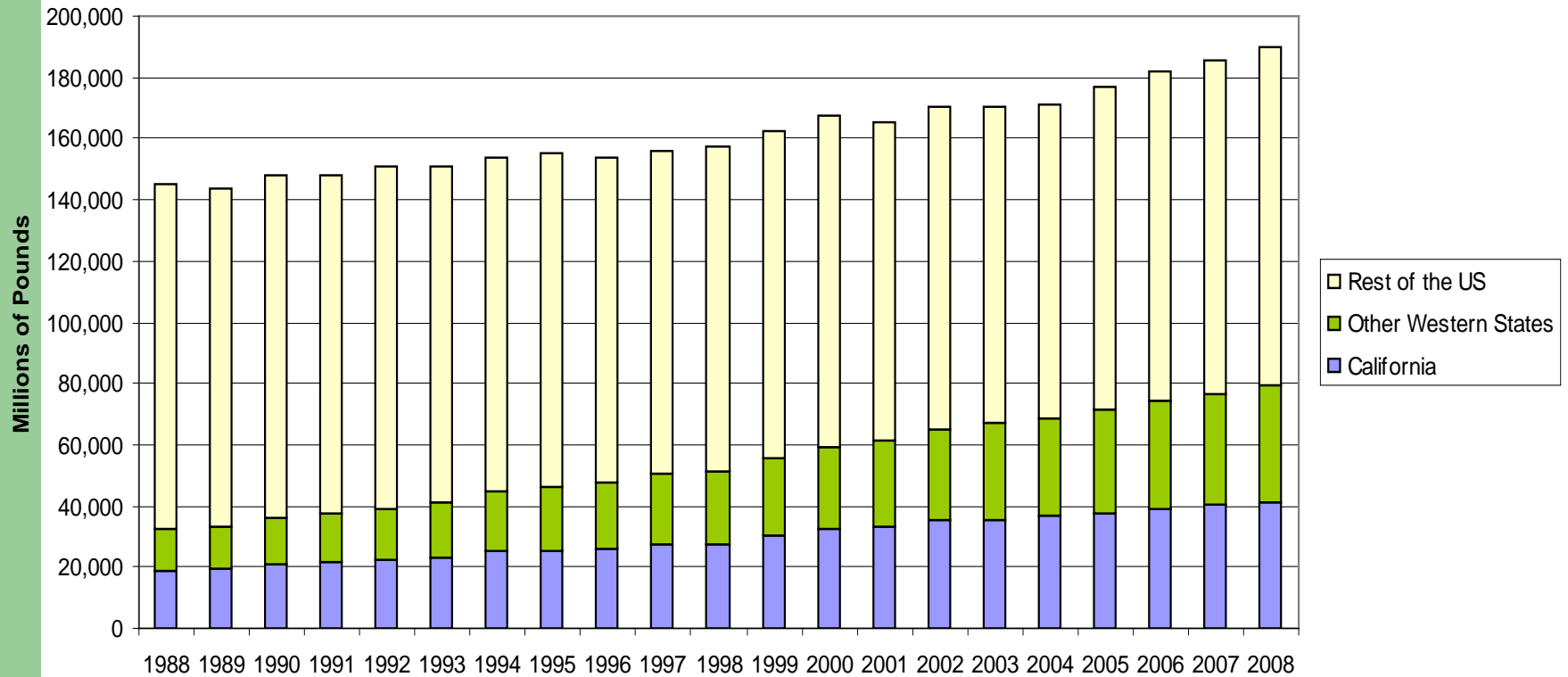

Milk Production, Yearly Percentage Change 1988-2008



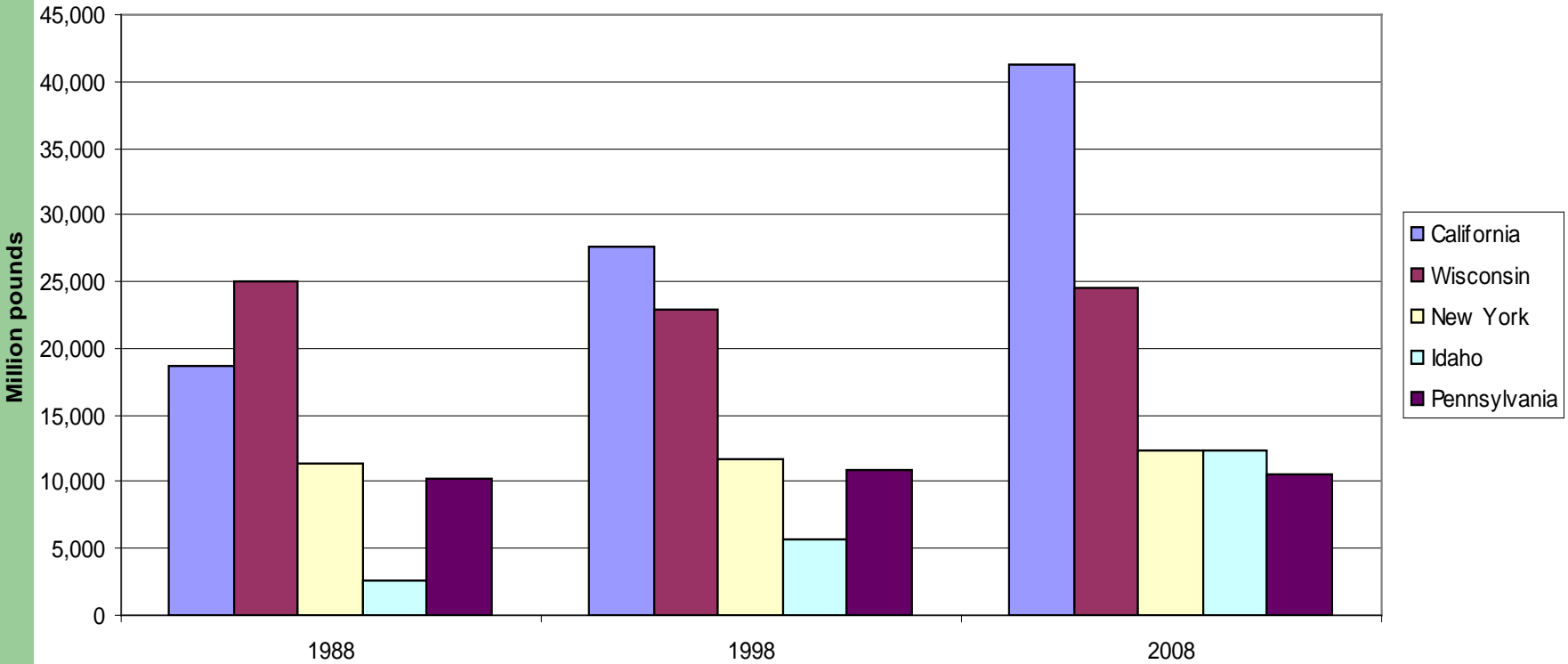

Milk Production 1988-2008



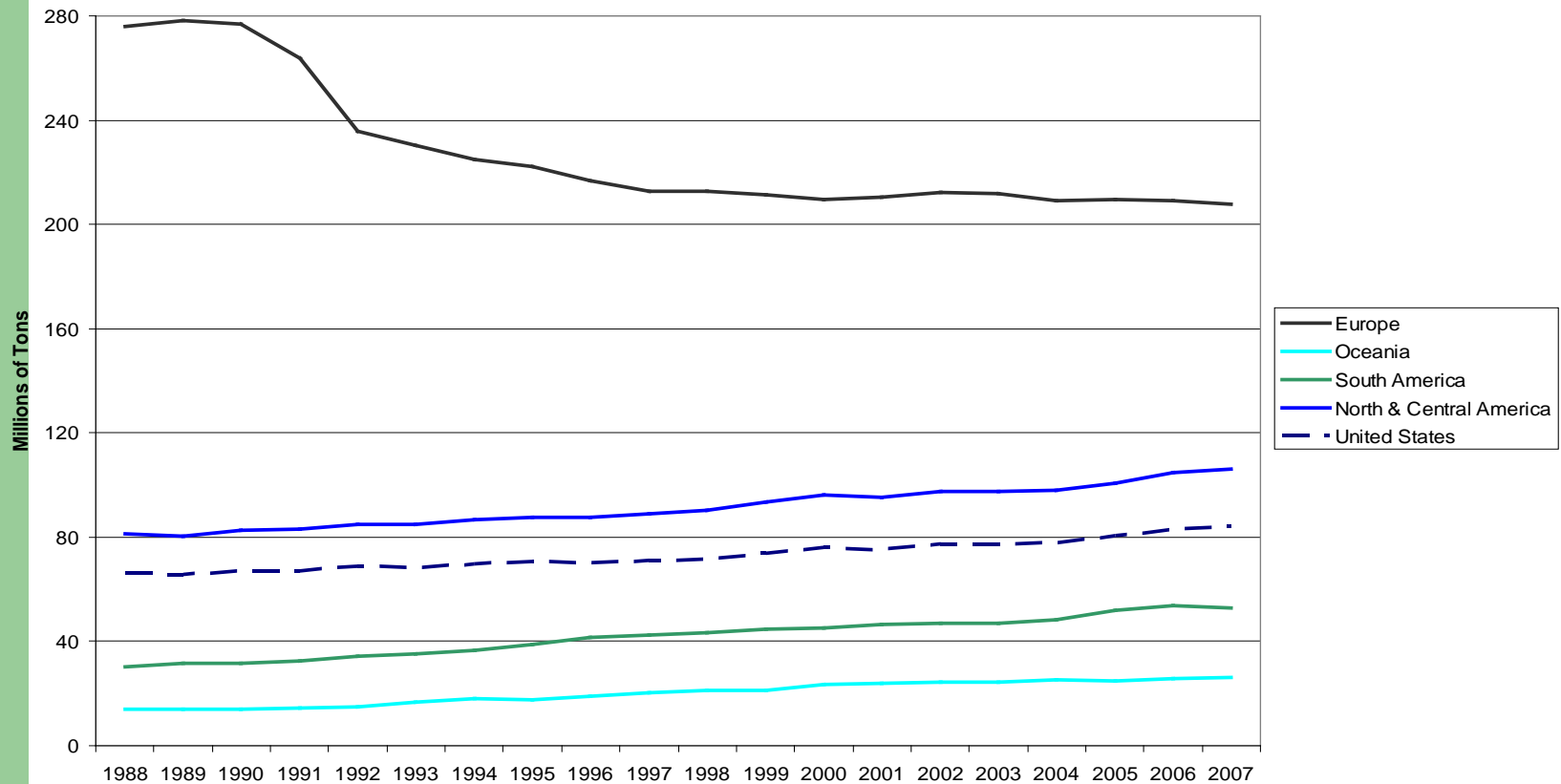
